Dear Mr McDonnell

The Manager Assessment material you have forwarded to this office in relation to a subclass 136/138 visa application has now been examined and I advise that based on the information received your skills have been assessed as suitable for the purpose of skilled migration.

To satisfy these requirements applicants must have a record of proven management achievement over a period of five years or more in a senior management position at the level of an Associate Fellow of AIM such as a chief executive, general manager or senior functional manager.

The years of experience may be reduced if an applicant has educational qualifications in management studies or business administration assessed as comparable to an Australian AQF Advanced Diploma, Bachelor degree, Master Degree, or in a discipline relevant to the field in which the manager is working. In your case you would receive one (1) year credit against required experience, thus requiring four years in a senior management position..

We believe you have held a senior management position since October 1997, a period of four years four months, and together with your relevant formal qualifications you would meet the criteria for a senior manager at the Associate Fellow level and satisfy the skills requirement for migration.
